Procedure for dealing with an injury on the Green to a work party member

To support this procedure, the following will always be available during a work party -

- A first aid kit for self-administration by the injured person
- A map and list of post codes showing access points to the Green
- Keys to the Green gates will be available with the first aid kit.
- Mobile phones with numbers exchanged to ensure that all members of the work party can be contacted. Additionally, mobile numbers may be kept in a sealed envelope in the first aid kits.
- A car should be available to transport a person to the medical centre if required.
- An accident book will be kept in the storage containers.
- Next of kin contacts should be available at the containers so that the injured person's family/friends can be contacted.

Following a **significant** accident to a work party member, the following will be enacted

- 1. All work party members will take actions to ensure their own safety before helping the injured person.
- 2. All work will stop and all work party members will meet up as requested by the work party leader.
- 3. As appropriate, 999 should be dialled to summon help from the emergency services. If this option is taken
 - Someone with a telephone will stay with the injured person at all times and hold the telephone that was used to make the 999 call
 - A person will be sent to open the access gates onto the green to allow emergency vehicle access.
 - Within the capabilities of the work party, assistance will be given to the injured person.
- 4. If appropriate the injured person may be taken to the Halesworth medical Surgery for assessment / treatment

The following will be carried out after the initial actions are completed

- 1. If required, relatives / friends of the injured person will be contacted
- 2. The accident book will be completed.
- 3. Any defective equipment which led to the accident will be taken out of service and assessed for future usage
- 4. The first aid kits will be inspected and any used items will be replaced
- 5. The Trustees will ensure that the Management Group consider the event and that appropriate actions are put in place to prevent reoccurrence.
- 6. This procedure will be reviewed after each time it is used to catch any lessons learnt.

Following minor injuries to a work party member the following will be carried out

- 5. The first aid kits may be used to allow the injured person to self-administer first aid
- 6. The accident book will be completed.
- 7. An immediate assessment will be made by the work party leader as to whether any additional actions are deemed necessary.
