The Halesworth Millennium Green Trust is committed to providing a safe and healthy working environment for volunteers and contractors as well as an environment in which members of the public can safely enjoy the Green.

We will achieve this by:

- Consulting with volunteers on matters affecting health and safety
- Providing and maintaining safe plant and equipment
- Ensuring safe handling and use of hazardous substances
 - Providing appropriate information, instruction and supervision for contractors and volunteers
- Ensuring that all contractors and volunteers are competent to carry out their tasks and providing adequate training for those tasks.
- Ensuring that risk assessments are carried out, together with appropriate resultant actions, to protect the health and safety of all persons working on the Green and members of the public visiting the Green and attending activities.
- Developing codes of practice for all areas of activity including the emergency procedures and access information for emergency services.

Ultimate responsibility for health and safety rests with the Trustees.

All contractors and volunteers must:

- Have a duty of care for their own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by their acts or omissions
- Co-operate with the Trustees on health and safety matters
- Report all health and safety concerns to the Trustees
