Equipment Operator	<ul> <li>Contact with moving parts</li> <li>Flying debris</li> <li>Slips Trips and falls</li> <li>Exhaust fumes</li> <li>Weather</li> <li>Contact with fuel</li> <li>Fire</li> <li>Noise</li> <li>Vibration</li> </ul>	Medium	Low	<ul> <li>An equipment safety check will be carried out at the start of each work period</li> <li>Appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) shall be worn including - <ol> <li>Snug fitting long trousers and long sleeved shirts</li> <li>Steel toe capped footwear</li> <li>Safety helmet with either mesh visor or safety glasses</li> <li>A harness shall be worn to support the machine and the equipment will be operated by two hands</li> <li>Ear defenders shall be worn by the operator at all times</li> <li>Suitable protective Gloves</li> <li>No lone working is permitted.</li> <li>The equipment will not be operated if there is anyone within a 15m radius.</li> <li>The equipment will not be operated of debris that may cause a hazard before work begins e.g. bottles, tin cans and dog excrement.</li> <li>The equipment will not be used on steep slopes where stable footing can not be maintained.</li> <li>The operator will take a 10 minute break after every tank of fuel with a 30 minute break after every 3 tanks.</li> <li>The equipment should not be used in strong winds or heavy rainfall.</li> <li>Operators should not be used within 15 m of a naked flame and no smoking is allowed in the work area, fuel storage area or equipment maintenance area.</li> <li>Protective gloves should not be urn indoors to prevent fume build up.</li> <li>The equipment should not be run indoors to prevent fume build up.</li> <li>The engine must be stopped prior to any maintenance being carried out on the equipment.</li> </ol></li></ul>

To alert the public of the work party.</li> <li>Signs should be placed either side of the work area to alert members of the public of the cutting operation.</li> </ul>
The Environment	<ul><li>Fuel</li><li>Fire</li></ul>	Medium	Low	<ul> <li>Store fuel to avoid ignition from any source such as fires or people smoking. Select a site shaded from direct sunlight and away from watercourses.</li> <li>Use fuel containers that incorporate a non spill spout. The containers must be clearly labelled and have caps that fit securely.</li> </ul>
