## Tasks for Jan – Mar workparties

**Ken** kindly offered to do 2 work parties per month for the next period, using one each month as the orchard work party.

**Email** was agreed as the best way of communicating.

**Jan 10<sup>th</sup>** Ken Clear vegetation on acid grassland bank in The Folly (actually finished clearing up willow wherry brash and pollarding willow arch)

**Jan 17<sup>th</sup>** Peter Coppicing in Arthur's Wood (actually now (11-1-24) plan is to clear fallen tree on 'towpath' beside New Reach, and work on that hedge)

**Jan 24<sup>th</sup>** Nicky Finish edge clearance up the all-weather track from 2 Acres to road

**Jan 31<sup>st</sup>** Ken Orchard work

**Feb 7<sup>th</sup>** Peter to be decided One of these February weeks must be checking cattle fencing

**Feb 14<sup>th</sup>** Ken to be decided

**Feb 21<sup>st</sup>** Nicky to be decided

**Feb 28<sup>th</sup>** Ken Orchard

**Work party management** - keep as one group if possible – or two close together if possible.

Delegate/designate one particular person to lead a subgroup if necessary to do a separate job.

**Batteries** – convention is that whoever uses the battery operated machines will take batteries away to recharge for the next week.

**Petrol** - Leader checks there's at least one can of petrol at end of work party.

Red cans = 4stroke – all mowers. Green cans = 2stroke - strimmers.

They live in separate shipping containers.

**Invitation email** - The person leading the work party sends out the invitation – from the Green's email box.
